Company Sales Value in Q2'FY23 improved by 46% from the same period of last year mainly from better pricing. On Consolidated basis, Net profit in this quarter Q2 FY22-23 is THB 1,912 Mn higher by THB 413 Mn against profit of THB 1,499 Mn in Q2FY21-22. On Standalone basis, Net Profit is THB 1,358 Mn higher by THB 416 Mn against profit of THB 942 Mn in Q1FY21-22. Main reason for the robust performance is better pricing, improvement in performance of associate companies & forex gain from depreciation of THB against USD. Company continues to take measures to control the cost, improve the quality and delivery matrices through incorporation of best practices.
