Company's Operating profit for Q2'FY24 has improved by 9% as compared to the same period of last year as sales volumes increased and Oil prices were also relatively lower.

On a Consolidated basis, Net profit for this quarter Q2 FY23-24 is THB 1,216 Mn as against net profit of THB 1,912 Mn in Q2 FY22-23 mainly due to lower share of income from associates and a lower exchange gain from fluctuations of THB against USD as compared during same period of last year.

On Stand-alone basis, Net Profit is THB 872 Mn as compared to net profit of THB 1,358 Mn in Q2 FY22-23 mainly due to lower exchange gain from fluctuations of THB against USD as mentioned above as compared during same period of last year.
