Subject Report of the Resolutions of Board of Directors' Meeting No.3/2018

To President
The Stock Exchange of Thailand

The Board of Directors' meeting of Cal-Comp Electronics (Thailand) Public Company Limited (the "Company") No. 3/2018 was held on Aug 13, 2018 the following resolutions were passed:

1. The Board of Directors approved the declaration of interim dividend payment for the first half of the year ending June 30, 2018 to shareholders of the Company for Baht 0.06 per share. The total number of outstanding shares entitled for the dividend is 4,554,643,575 shares and total dividend amount is Baht 273,278,614.50

The record date for the shareholders who have right to receive the interim dividend will be on September 4, 2018. The interim dividend will be paid on September 13, 2018 from net profit that still enjoys the tax exemption for corporate income from BOI, therefore, the dividend is free for income tax.
